

## 1.4 Naming Devices

### TASK IDS

#### Windows and VMS

Task IDs must be two, three or four characters long. The first character is usually T, but the following characters are also allowed: A, B, E, H, I, J, K, M, U, V, W, X, Y, Z. Valid second, third, and fourth characters are 0-9 and A-Z.

#### UNIX/Linux

Task IDs must be two, three or four characters long. The first character is usually T, but the following characters are also allowed: A, B, E, H, I, J, K, M, U, V, W, X, Y, Z, and a-z. Valid second, third, and fourth characters are 0-9, A-Z, and a-z.

### GHOST TASKS

#### Windows

Not supported.

#### VMS

36 Ghost Tasks are supported that must be configured in order: G0-G9 and GA-GZ.

#### UNIX/Linux

62 Ghost Tasks are supported that must be configured in order: G0-G9, GA-GZ, and Ga-Gz.

### DISK DIRECTORIES

#### Windows/VMS/UNIX/Linux

Disk Directory names must be two characters long. D0-D9, DA-DZ, and Da-Dz are allowed. Directories are searched in the order listed, not in name order. Disk Numbers are based on the second character: D0-D9 = 0-9, DA-DZ = 10-35, Da-Dz = 36-61.

### PRINTERS

#### Windows/VMS/UNIX/Linux

Printer names must be two characters long. The first character is usually L or P, but the following characters are also allowed: C, F, N, O, Q, R, S, 0-9, and a-z. Valid second characters are: 0-9, A-Z, and a-z.
