

QUICK UPDATE *BASIC* ONLY FOR LEVEL 8.4 *BASIC*

1. Login as SYSTEM manager, when noone is running Thoroughbred *Basic*.
2. Make a temporary directory if you don't have one:

```
$ CREATE/DIRE SYS$SYSDEVICE:[000000.TBTEMP]
```
3. *If installing from tape:* Mount the update tape and restore with BACKUP.

```
$ BACK/LOG MUA0: SYS$SYSDEVICE:[TBTEMP]*.*;*
```

OR

If installing from CD: mount/ov=id cdrom: , then

```
$back/log/noassi cdrom:[000000]tbred_basic084.a/save -  
SY$SYSDEVICE:[TBTEMP]*.*;*
```

4.

```
$ SET DEF SYS$SYSTEM  
$ INSTALL  
>INSTALL REMOVE TBRED_BASIC:TBRED84  
>INSTALL <CTL>Z
```
5.

```
$ SET DEF TBRED_BASIC
```
6.

```
$ COPY SYS$SYSDEVICE:[TBTEMP]$$0BASIC.UNI TBRED.UNI
```
7.

```
$ RENAME TBRED84.EXE TBRED84.SAVE
```
8.

```
$ COPY SYS$SYSDEVICE:[TBTEMP]$$0A_INSTALL.EXE INSTALL.EXE
```
9. *If you are changing the number of users, or using a new serial number OR you are reinstalling because of an O/S upgrade, you must also:*

```
$ RENAME  
TBREDBAS.84 TBREDBAS.OLD84
```

If you have not done a major VMS upgrade or moved your system disk INSTALL should run without the media being mounted or the need for a new activation key. If you are changing the serial number, or a VMS upgrade has caused your BASIC to stop working, you must do step 9 above. If you did step 9, you will have to call for a new activation after installation is complete.

```
$ TBINSTALL ::= $TBRED_BASIC:INSTALL.EXE
```
11.

```
TBINSTALL -N
```
12.

```
$_SYS$MANAGER:TBRED_STARTUP
```
13.

```
$TBASIC
```
14. Proceed with activation if necessary.
